**Eligibility**

- 1. Master's Programme in Applied Linguistics (English Language Teaching) International Programme—Weekday, Weekend**
  - 1.1 Applicants for admission to the MA programmes must hold a bachelor's degree from accredited institutions in Thailand or overseas in related fields.
  - 1.2 English proficiency is required for entering the programme. Applicants should meet the following requirements:
    - For the Master's programme, TOEFL minimum score 500 marks (paper-based) or 173 marks (computer-based), or IELTS minimum score 5.0
  
- 2. Master's Programme in English for Professional and International Communication International Programme—Weekend**
  - 2.1 Applicants for admission to the MA programmes must hold a bachelor's degree from accredited institutions in Thailand or overseas.
  - 2.2 English proficiency is required for entering the programme. Applicants should meet the following requirements:
    - For the Master's programme, TOEFL minimum score 500 marks (paper-based) or 173 marks (computer-based), or IELTS minimum score 5.0
  
- 3. Ph.D. Programme in Applied Linguistics (International Programme)**
  - 3.1 Applicants need to achieve a final GPA of 3.25 or more in their master degree studies in English Language Teaching or related field from accredited institutions in Thailand or overseas by the Office of The Civil Service Commission.
  - 3.2 English proficiency is required for entering the programme. To apply for studentship, applicants should meet the following requirements:
    - TOEFL minimum score 230 marks (computer-based), or IELTS minimum score 6.5
  - 3.3 Applicants should have teaching experience or have worked in the field of education or have experience teaching English.
